CWFL Round Up Saturday 13th February 2016

Birkenhead Town will be the sole representatives for the CWFL in this seasons **Wirral District FA Junior Cup** Final when they look to defend the trophy for a record fourth time after defeating Franklyn's 4-0 thanks to goals from Mike Parnell 2, Danny Amis and Dava Bowe. They will play Mersey Royal Youth of the West Cheshire League who beat CWFL side New Ferry Rangers 5-0 in the other semi final.

Samba needed extra time and penalties to see off Hoole Rangers in their rearranged **CWFL Goals Soccer Centre Chester Cayzer Shield** Round One tie. Ian Johnston was the scorer for Samba in normal time and James Holroyd hit a last minute equaliser in extra time to force the game in spot kicks. Samba held their nerve and ran out 5-4 winners on penalties and will now face Clubbies in round 2 next week. In the days round 2 games Woodchurch move into the last 8 after seeing off Ellesmere Port Town III 4-0. Neston Town will also be in the draw after goals from Rob Jones and Lee Exel gave them a 2-0 win over Cestrian. Elton Rigger had a fine 5-1 away win at Hoole Youth thanks to strikes from Wayne Clarke, Jez St Lawrence, and subs Ben Jones 2 and Tom Senior. Elton Athletic need extra time in their 4-3 win over MBNA. An own goal, Joe Ormrod and Adam Hall scored in normal time for Athletic to cancel out goals for MBNA from Tom Povey 2, and Paul Jones, leaving the game 3-3 at full time, until a Jake Harrison extra time winner for Elton saw them safely through.

In the **CWFL Dee 1063 League Cup** Lache progressed at the expense of Christleton Celtic after a 4-0 win with goals from Sam Spridgeon 2, Liam McGovern and Sam Buckley. Lee O'Donnell, Levi Woolley and Andy Blakeborough were the scorers for Higher Bebington Kelma in their 3-2 win over Chester Nomads III. Neston Nomads went down 2-0 at home to Lodge Bar while Shaftesbury Youth need extra time to beat Kelsall 4-2. Shafts were 2-0 down and looked to be down and out until a spirited fight back that saw goals from John McGra and Brian Griffiths forced the tie into extra time with an extra time brace from Jacob Drayton sealing the game for them.

In the **CWFL Queensferry Sports Premier Division** Whitby Athletic got back to winning ways with a 4-3 home win over neighbours Ellesmere Port Town Reserves with goals coming from Paul Butler, Corey Bevan, Mark Lowe and an own goal.

In **CWFL Link Up Division Two** Eastham Athletic and Orange Athletic fought out a 3-3 draw in their game with the Orange goals coming via Dave Jacks 2 and Elliott Wright.

In the **CWFL Tarvin Precision Vets Division** Ashton Vets and Dee Rangers Vets shared the points after a 2-2 draw, Mike Astbury hitting both goals for Ashton.
