## CWFL Round Up Saturday 9<sup>th</sup> April 2015

Blacon Thistle hit the road as they continue to gain momentum as the season reaches an end. They travelled to Ashley and Tyldsley in the **Northern Cup** third round tie and did not disappoint, putting in a stunning performance. Despite going a goal down early on in the game strikes by Gary Roberts, Luke Jones and Lloyd Ellams ensured that the bus ride home was a memorable one as they finished 3-1 winners. This now means that they will be playing fellow CWFL side Neston Nomads Reserves in the semi final on a date still to be set.



In the **CWFL Queensferry Sports Premier Division** Lache suffered their biggest league defeat in almost five years at the hands of Deva Athletic. Deva goals from Dom Kennedy, Dave Suddaby and Hat Trick hero Joe Connolly were enough for them to ease past the champions 5-1. Birkenhead Town made the most of the slip by Lache, beating Higher Bebington Kelma 3-0 thanks to an Andrew Bolton hat trick. This win sees the Town retake top spot and with only a handful of games to play things could not be tighter. At the other end of the table Uberlube moved off bottom place after a 3-1 win over Shaftesbury Youth thanks to goals from Andrew Whitton, Nathan Collins and Steven Dodd. In the divisions other game Christleton Celtic had Joe Muir and Daniel Griffiths on the scoresheet as they fought out a 2-2 draw with Ellesmere Port Town Reserves.

Elton Rigger continue their run of good form after beating Orange Athletic 2-0 thanks to goals from Ash Antcliffe and Wayne Clark. Crossway put in a great performance, seeing off Eastham Athletic 4-1. Their scorers were Jake Powell, Todd Davies 2 and Paul Seddon.
