Lloyd Ellams hit the winner for Blacon with Ryan Atherton replying for the Town. Second placed Newton Athletic were pushed all the way for their 5-4 win over Lodge Bar. Newton's scorers were Ben Woodman with a hatrick, Liam Bradley and Danny Morgan. Ian Johnson hit the winner for Ellesmere Port in their 1-0 win over MBNA whilst Aaron Hinchcliffe 3, Josh Gannon and Chris Simmons were all on target for Christleton Celtic as they eased past Ellesmere Port Town Reserves 5-1; Ellis Williams hit the consolation for the Port.

Clubbies move into second place in the **CWFL Olympic Trophies Division One** with a fine 3-0 over FC UBER with goals coming from Liam McGovern and Mikey Edwards 2.
