The weather once again took its toll on the CWFL with 10 games falling by the wayside due to waterlogged pitches. One game survived the **CWFL Queensferry Sports Premier Division** and it was a 9-goal thriller between Franklyn's and Ellesmere Port Town A. Franklyn's came away with all 3 points thanks to strikes from Nana Eneh 2, Steve Rothwell 2 and Sam McLachlan. Connor Howley 2, Mike Large and Reece Sharrock replied for the Port.

Upton are now just 2 points of top place in the **CWFL Olympic Trophies Division One** after a fine 5-2 win over Hoole Rangers. Jay Wong put in a man of the match performance and assisted in goals for Joe Williams 4 and Danny Evans as they claimed all 3 points. Andy Johnson and Mark Brown replied for Hoole.
