CWFL Round Up Saturday 24th March 2018

Spring has arrived and the CWFL were able to offer a full program of fixtures for the first time in weeks. In the **CWFL Cayzer Shield** rearranged Quarter Final St Saviours were leading Clubbies 3-0 until the game was cut short after the latter went down to 6 men. Shaftesbury Youth are now leading the way in the **CWFL Queensferry Sports Premier Division**. Ian McGraa, Danny Whitehead, Mike Watkins and Jake Drayton were all on the score sheet for the Shafts as they beat Helsby 4-0 away.
