CWFL Round Up Saturday 21st September 2019

It was a busy day for CWFL clubs with teams playing in both the W DFA Senior Cup and Northern Cup. In the **W DFA Senior Cup** Ashville of the West Cheshire League were too strong for Higher Bebington Kelma running out 5-0 winners.

In the **Northern Cup** CWFL teams fared slightly better with wins for Neston Nomads Vets over St Mary's COB FC with goals from Lee Cairns, Lee Dunbar, Pete Williams and an own goal.
