CWFL Flexi Football Round Up

It was great to see the CWFL back at Blacon High for the **CWFL Monday Night Flexi 11's Blacon Cup** this week after a 14-month break due to the COVID-19 pandemic. The venue was ready, the teams were set and the football did not disappoint. Blacon High Staff got proceedings underway with a 4-0 win over Deeside Chester with goals from Lewis Coppack 2, Aidan Shannon and an own goal. In the nights second game Hoole Rangers beat Highfield Horses by the odd goal in 5 thanks to efforts from Matty Sharpe and a Patrick Silveira brace. Over at Ellesmere Port in the **CWFL Monday Night 11's EPSV Cup** Jordan Finlay and Andy Smith both bagged a double for Ellesmere Port Villa in their 4-1 win over Chester Lions. At the same venue Champs League Warriors also recorded a 4-1 win in their game with Ship Argyle who had Ryan Parry on the score sheet.

On Friday in the **CWFL Vauxhalls Friday Night Flexi 11's Charlene Marie Trophy** Andy Ayerman was on target for Ship Argyle in their 1-0 win over The Youth FC. In the second game Halton Borough Town beat FC UBER 2-0.

At the **CWFL Warrington Friday Night Flexi 11's Orford Cup** Matty Mairs and Steve Jupp were on target for Winwick Athletic in the 2-1 win over Cromwell Park, Jacob Dimeloe with the reply. The nights other game saw Woodhey Allstars beat Unknown FC 4-0 with goals from Luke Nicholson 2, Joel Holden and Luke Holden.

In the **CWFL Moss Farm Friday Night Flexi 11's** FC Beer Trading beat Weaver Fever 3-1 thanks to goals from Joe Lanceley, Adam Pickering and Jack Duffy. Kyle Lamb replied for Fever.

On Monday it was a good night for Blacon Youth FC as both their first and Reserve teams recorded 5-0 wins in the **Chester & District FA Challenge Cup**. Blacon Firsts win was over CWFL Leaders Upton JFC while the Reserves beat Crossway of the Monday Night Flexi Division in Ellesmere Port. In the other tie Chester Nomads II beat Cestrian Alex 4-1.

In the **CWFL Tarvin Precision Vets Division 2** Ashton Vets beat Dee Rangers Vets 8-1 with goals from Luca Trasatti 3, Rhys Nevett 2, Mike Astbury, Paul Stubbs and Matt Edwards. Tarvin Athletic Vest beat Hartford Vets 5-0 and Upton JFC Vets beat Frodsham Park JFC Vets 5-2.

In the **CWFL Tarvin Precision Vets Division 3** Phil Evans 2 and Daniel Norris were the marksmen for Ellesmere Port Red Lions in their 3-0 win over Winsford Diamonds while FC Vaults beat Great Sutton Vets 2-1.

On Wednesday Night in the **CWFL Olympic Trophies Championship A** Helsby Reserves and Upton JFC Youth took a point each from their 8-goal thriller. Ryan Bond 2, Jim King and Ryan Merryweather were the Helsby scorers with Caelen McGovern and Jack Sconce replying for Upton. Chester Nomads III's edged a 4-3 win over Hoole Rovers thanks to strikes from Caleb Rose, Macaulay Salter, Cam Parker and Lewis Coppack.

The game between Avenue Vets and Capenhurst Villa Vets in the **CWFL Tarvin Precision Vets Division One** was awarded to Avenue after Capenhurst failed to raise a side.

The pressure appears to be building in the **CWFL Queensferry Sports Premier Division** with all the top 3 teams losing points. Leaders Upton JFC went down 4-1 to Groves Athletic despite opening up the scoring with a Paul Johnson effort. George Patchett lead the fight back for the Groves scoring a hatrick with Liam Smith adding a fourth from the spot. St Saviours suffered a 3-1 defeat at the hands of the resurging Shaftesbury Youth who had Lee Griffiths 2 and Danny Smith on the scoresheet. Shafts now sit in fourth, 5 points from the top with a game in hand on St Saviours and Uitor. Uitor were held to a 1-1 draw in their game with the improving Higher Bebington Kelma. Derek Taylor was the Uitor scorer with Andy Blakeborough scoring for Kelma. That was Kelma's fourth draw of the season; if they could just convert these into wins they would now be sitting second! Ellesmere Port put 3 welcome points on their record after a 2-1 win over Blacon Youth Reserves. Goals from Matt Crowe and Danny Hale secured their win with Sam Burgess replying for Blacon.

Cestrian Alex and Hoole Rangers fought out a 3-3 draw in their **CWFL Olympic Trophies Championship A** encounter. Matt Gilmour 2 and Elliot Davies were the Alex marksmen with Connor Howley, Callum Jones and Aaron Eymond hitting home for Rangers. Owen Ainscough got the only goal of the game for Shaftesbury Youth Reserves in their 1-0 win over Princes Villa.

Things are hotting up in the **CWFL Olympic Trophies Championship B** with only 2 points separating the top 3 teams. Overnight leaders FC Duddon Utd met second place Waggon but neither side could muster the win as the game ended 1-1. Ellis Moore had put the Waggon in front but a late equaliser from Tom Evans gave the home side a point. The 100% Black Horse took full advantage of this and moved into top place after a 5-1 away win over Chester Nomads IV's thanks to goals from Jamie Hurworth, Chris Davies 2, Kynan Mason and Gordon Harrison. Winsford Saxons are still in with a shout sitting in fourth and in a rich vein of form. They recorded a 9-0 win over the brave Poulton Vics side with goals coming from Sam Fallows 4, Callum Herbert 3, Dylan Williams and Tom Daly. Fifth placed Runcorn Sports are looking to crash the party and displayed their ambition with a resounding 8-0 win over Neston Nomads Development. Jack Harper lead the scoring with 5 followed by Mike Jackson, Matty Hayes and

Aaron Pickavant. Tom Astill and Dan Nixon both scored for Orange Athletic in their 3-2 loss against Rossmore Rangers.

Upton JFC Vets kept their 100% record in the **CWFL Tarvin Precision Vets Division 2** with a fine 3-2 win over Ashton Vets, Chris Melia lead the scoring with a brace with Ben Walley adding a third. Second placed Tarvin Athletic Vets beat Dee Rangers Vets 7-0 while Nags Head Bunbury Vets and Frodsham Park JFC Vets ended in a 1-1 draw. Henry Buckley was the Nags Head scorer.

In the **CWFL Tarvin Precision Vets Division 3** Third placed FC Vaults beat Crossway Vets 4-3 and Great Sutton Vets went down 5-1 to Winsford Diamond Vets who had Matty Walmsley, Ricky Billinge, Michael Warburton 2 and Dave Garstang to thank for their goals.
